Woodstock Music and Art Festival

Many of the festival performances were recorded and filmed and some of the songs that CSN&Y performed were released on the albums **Woodstock**, **Woodstock 2** ; in 1994 on the 4CD box set **Woodstock** and in 2009 on the 6CD box set **Woodstock 40** as indicated below, but only *Suite: Judy Blue Eyes* actually appears in director Michael Wadleigh's film which is widely available commercially on DVD and BD. The film also includes studio versions of *Long Time Gone*, *Woodstock* and *Wooden Ships*. Strangely these are different mixes from those released on **Crosby, Stills & Nash** and **Déjà vu**.

- A Released on the album and 2CD **Woodstock**. Brief film footage from *Suite: Judy Blue Eyes* was included in the VH-1 *Legends* CSNY special broadcast on March 12, 2000.
- B Released on the laserdisc **Woodstock: The Lost Performances**.
- C Appears on the video, DVD and CD **Woodstock Diary**.
- D Released on the album and 2CD **Woodstock 2**.
- E Released on the video and DVD **Long Time Comin'**. Brief film footage was included in the VH -1 *Legends* CSNY special broadcast on March 12, 2000.
- F Video released on disc 5 of the **Neil Young Archives Vol. 1** box set. Appeared on MTV and (audio) on the bootleg CD and LP **Touch The Clouds**. Also appears on the bootleg CD **Trail Of The Buffalo**. Brief footage was included in the VH -1 *Legends* CSNY special broadcast on March 12, 2000.
- G Released on the 4CD box set **Woodstock**. Audio of *Find The Cost Of Freedom* was included in the DVD **Woodstock The Director's Cut**.

A number of the seven officially released songs have appeared on bootleg CDs like **Woodstock Festival Live**, **Woodstock Freedom**, **Songwriters On Stage** and **California Dream If You Go To San Francisco**.

While the **Woodstock** album, 2CD and 4CD box set and the 6CD box set **Woodstock 40** contain a live version of *Sea Of Madness*, this was in fact recorded at the late show at the Fillmore East NYC on September 20, 1969.

In 2009, by way of celebration of the 40th anniversary of the festival, a new extended version of the **Woodstock** film was released as a 4 disc DVD set and a 2 disc BD set. The DVD **Woodstock Diary** was also reissued. The 6CD set **Woodstock 40** contained the six audio tracks that were released on the original CDs (references A and D).

For many years collectors have assumed that the only show known to have been taped unofficially was from August 26. It now seems almost certain that this tape is from August 31. *Down By The River* did not feature at the start of the run and was introduced only for the last few performances. Set lists from the other concerts have been compiled from newspaper reviews or personal reminiscences. It would seem likely that the electric sets for each show were identical apart from *Down By The River* as detailed previously. Any other variations would have occurred during the acoustic sets. The only other song known to have been performed on at least one occasion was *Marrakesh Express*.

All of the Greek Theatre shows were supported by Joni Mitchell.

Broadcast on September 22 in the USA by ABC TV, this was the first programme in *The Music Scene* series and it was greeted in the American music press with some enthusiasm. Rolling Stone, however, remarked on the lack of sound quality noting that "CSN&Y were especially tinny and poorly mixed." The running order for this debut show was James Brown, CSN&Y, Buck Owens, Oliver, Three Dog Night, Tom Jones and The Beatles.

The Music Scene

Video released on disc 5 of the *Neil Young Archives Vol. 1* box set. An edited version of this performance appears in *The Heroes of Rock and Roll*, broadcast on US TV and BBC TV in 1979 and is available on the video *Long Time Comin'*. The full version was available for some time on silent black and white film. The song was also released on the 4 cassette video compilation *Music Scene Vol. 1 - 4*. Appears on the bootleg CDs *Winterland Reunion*, *One Night Only* and *Trail Of The Buffalo*. An excerpt was included in the VH-1 *Legends* CSNY special broadcast on March 12, 2000 and the song is available on the DVD *Music Scene - The Best Of 1969-70*.

This Is Tom Jones

Part of *You Don't Have To Cry* was included in an episode of *The Story of Rock'n'Roll* made in the USA in 1987 and broadcast in the UK on Channel 4 on July 4, 1988. The full version is available on the video and DVD *Long Time Comin'*. Excerpts from both songs were included in the VH-1 *Legends* CSN&Y special broadcast on March 12, 2000.

Both songs appear on the bootleg 2CD *Five Way Street*.

Performances during the two days were filmed by Baird Bryant and Johanna Demetrakas and their film *Celebration At Big Sur* contains several items involving CSN&Y. Many of the songs listed, together with *World in Changes* and *Only You Know And I Know* performed by Dave Mason and Stephen Stills, are to be found on a tape, possibly from a radio broadcast, which is a compilation from both days. Stills also performed with various other artists.

K Appear on the bootleg 2CD *Big Sur Festival September 1969* together with the two Dave Mason songs mentioned above. The acoustic songs appear on the bootleg CD *Long Time Gone* and the electric songs appear on the bootleg CD *Bluebird Revisited*.

L Appear on the first CSN&Y bootleg LP *Wooden Nickel* and also appear on the bootleg CD *Old Cop*. The bootleg LP has appeared under other titles. *Bluebird Live* has tracks as per *Wooden Nickel*, *Ohio / Wooden Nickel* adds *Ohio* and *Find The Cost Of Freedom* and the LP *Ohio* adds *Ohio* and *Teach Your Children*. These extra tracks are the officially released studio recordings. The songs also appear on the bootleg CD *Wooden Nickel* which also includes CSN&Y live and studio material and Buffalo Springfield studio material.

N Appears on the bootleg 4CD set *Rock'n'Roll Cowboy*.

O Appear in the film *Celebration At Big Sur* which has been broadcast in the USA and Europe and is thus available unofficially from off-air recordings. *Down By The River* has been edited. Supported by Lonnie Mack the four shows at the Fillmore East grossed a total of \$52,000. There was extensive press coverage of these performances and the set lists above have been compiled from an audience tape and newspaper reviews. It would be reasonable to assume that the shows were very similar in content and in particular the electric sets would probably have been the same. Any variation would have been most likely to do with Stills and Young's solo songs.
